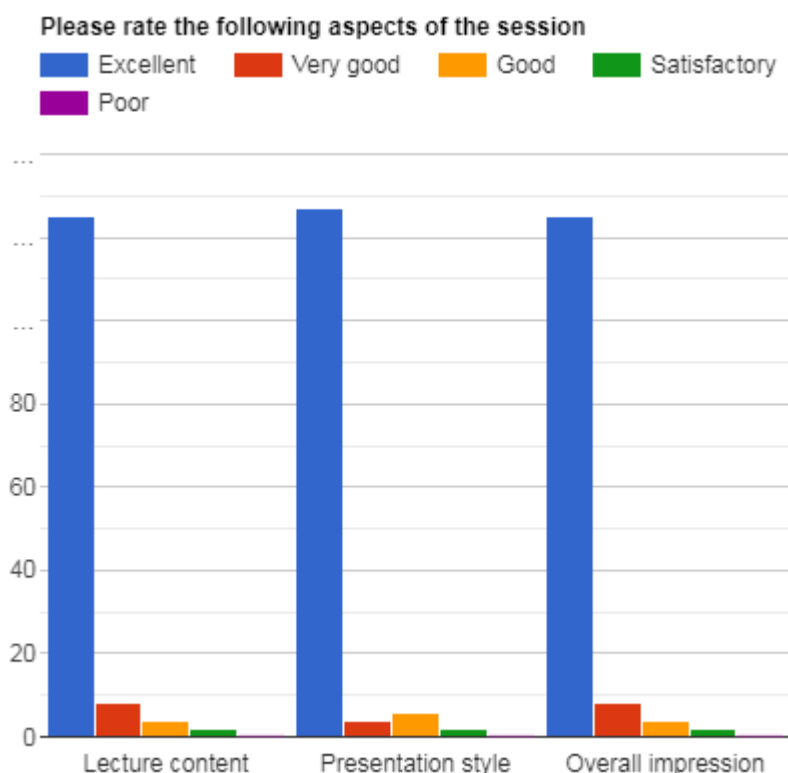

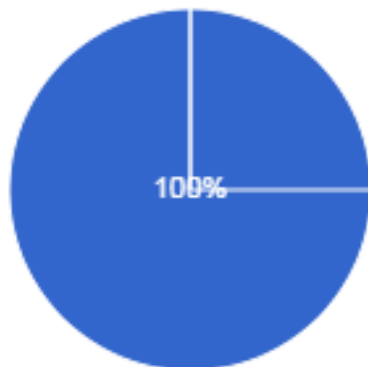
Summary Points:
