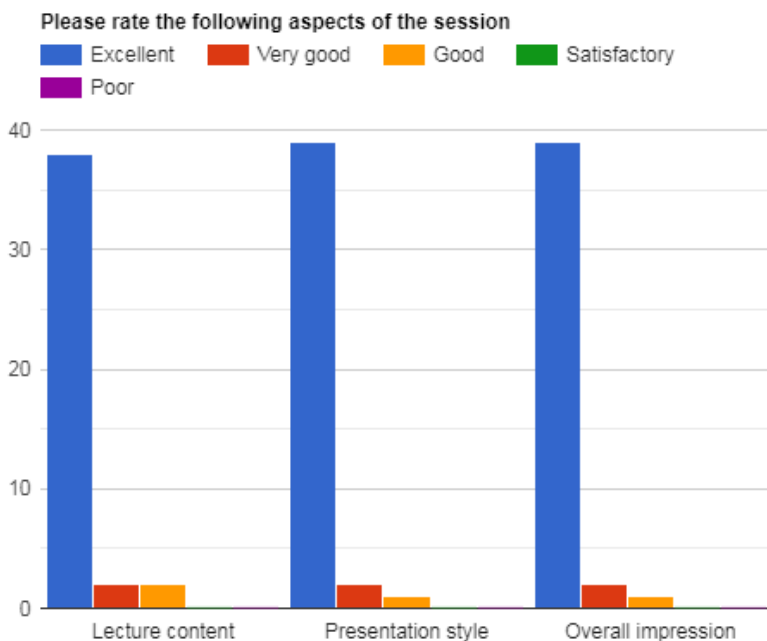

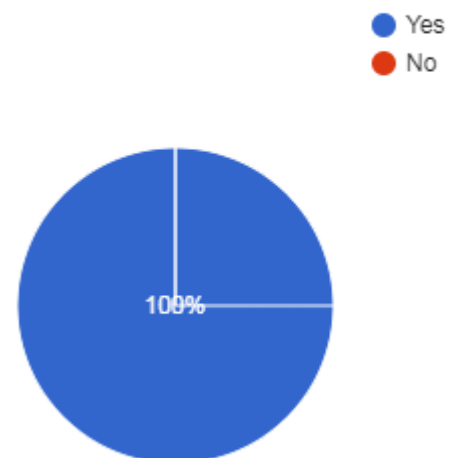

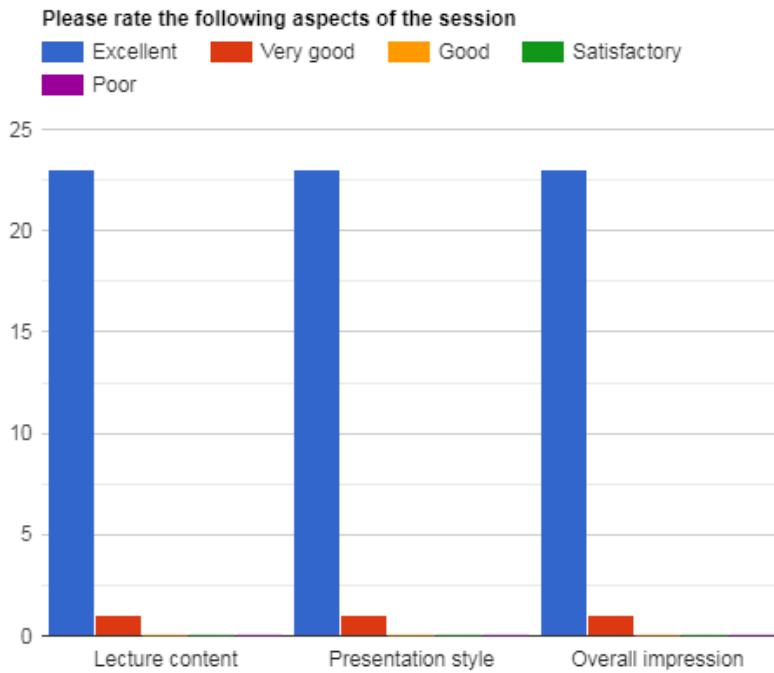

- Total feedback received from 77 participants, from three different broadcasts



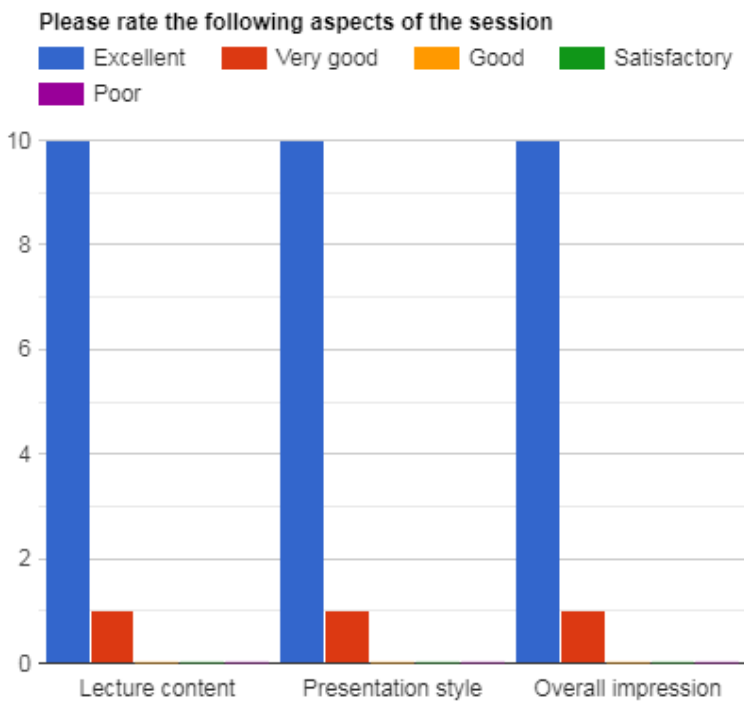
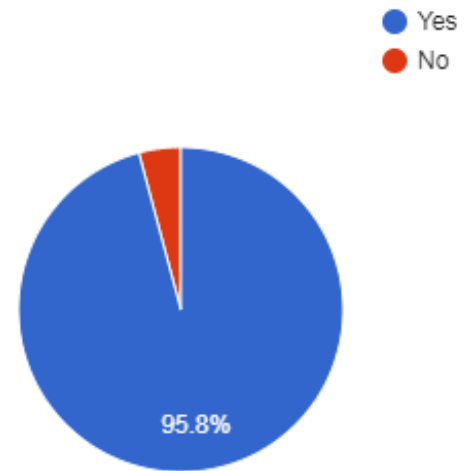
