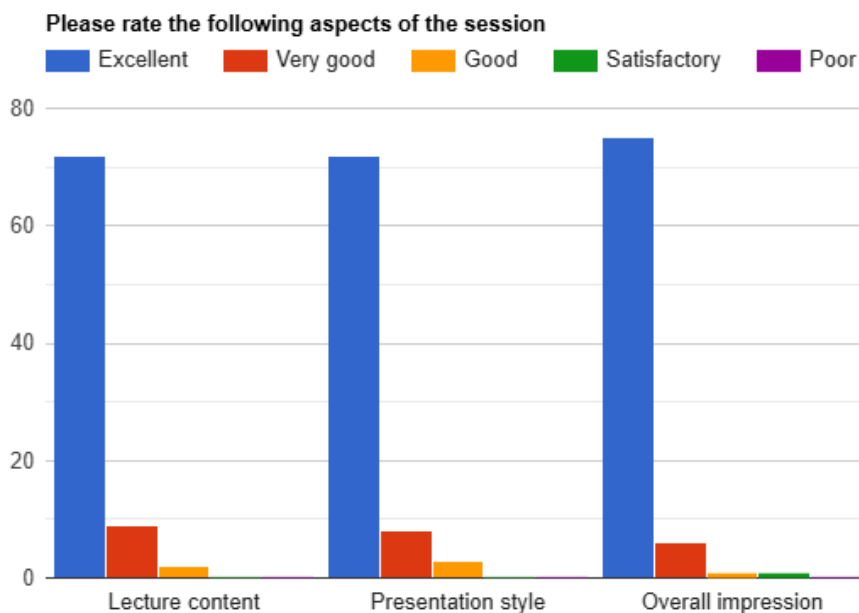

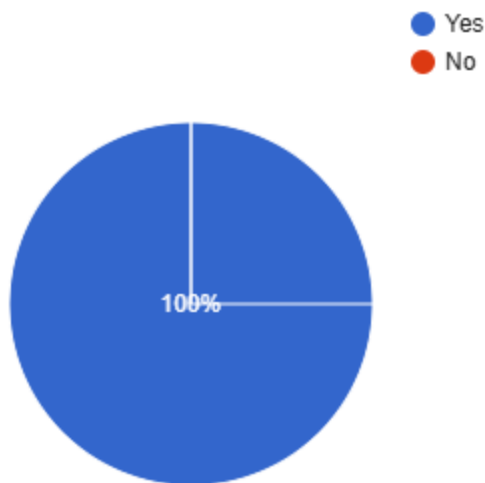

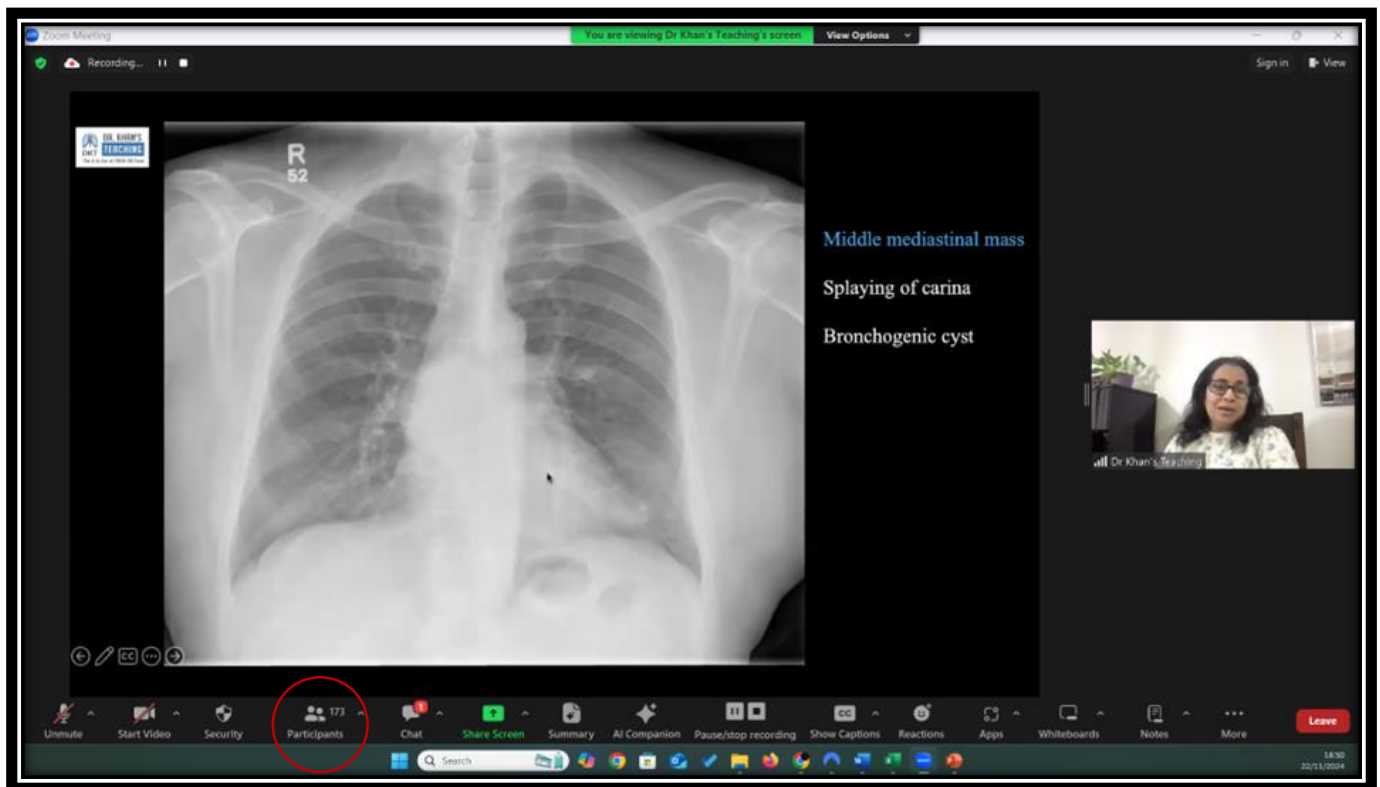
- I think the structure of teaching is incredibly helpful, not taught this much detail and systematic approach in medical school (UK).
