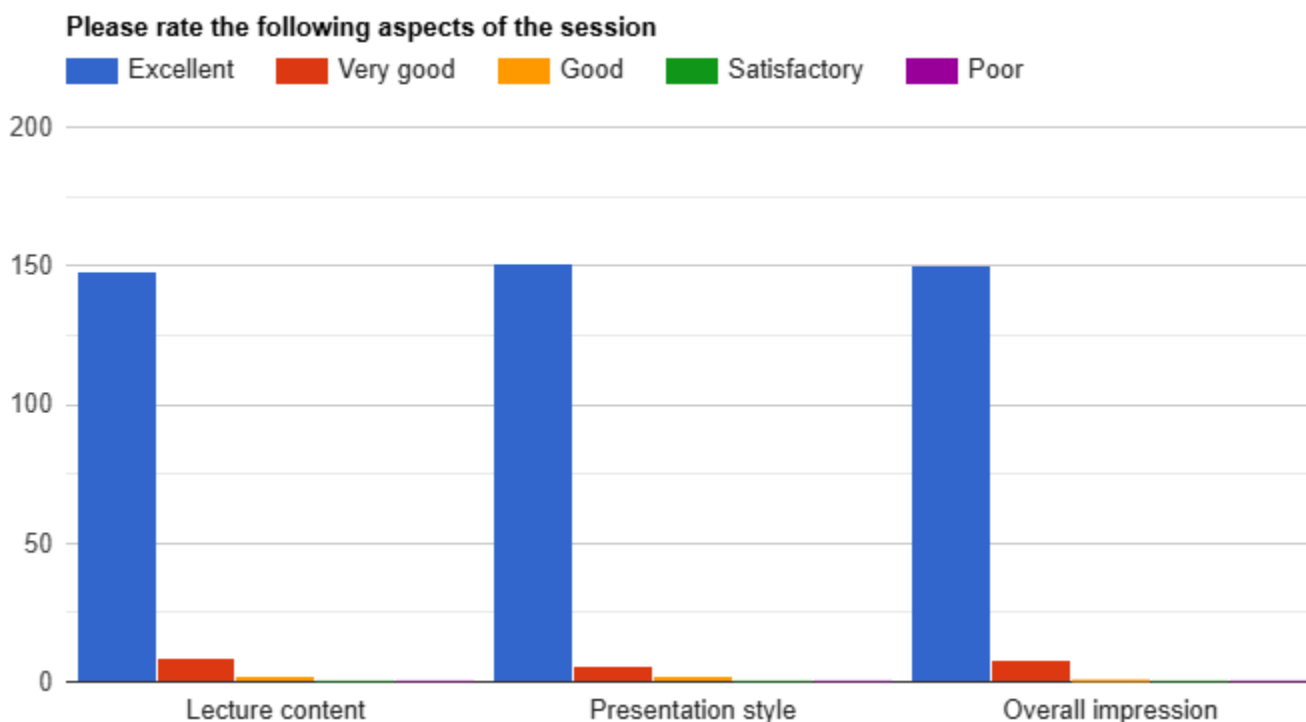

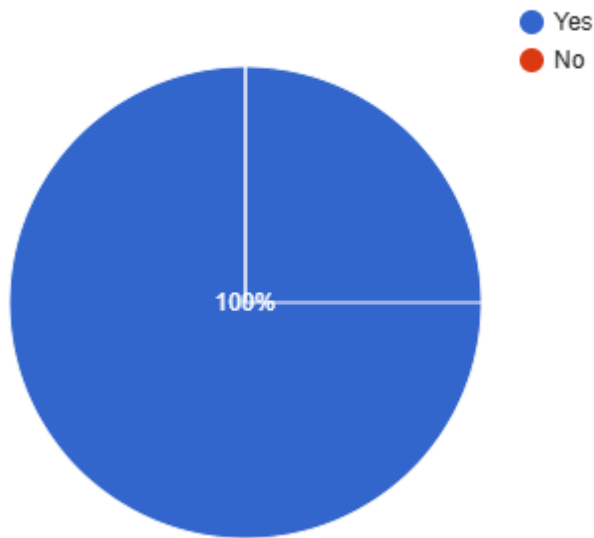

Example examiner marking guidance

Findings:
Bilateral pleural plaques indicating previous asbestos exposure
Left lower lobe collapse*
No visible hilar mass (no Goldens S sign)
DD central obstructing mass (small lung cancer or endobronchial lesion)

Management:
Review old imaging and, if new, expedite urgent CT chest/abdomen + IV contrast
Urgent referral to lung MDT/chest clinic

Comment: Consider mark for bronchoscopy and biopsy before CT. Mucous plugging less likely than central obstructing lesion but possible

(* = critical finding/diagnosis, phrases in brackets not essential, but can gain candidate extra marks)
