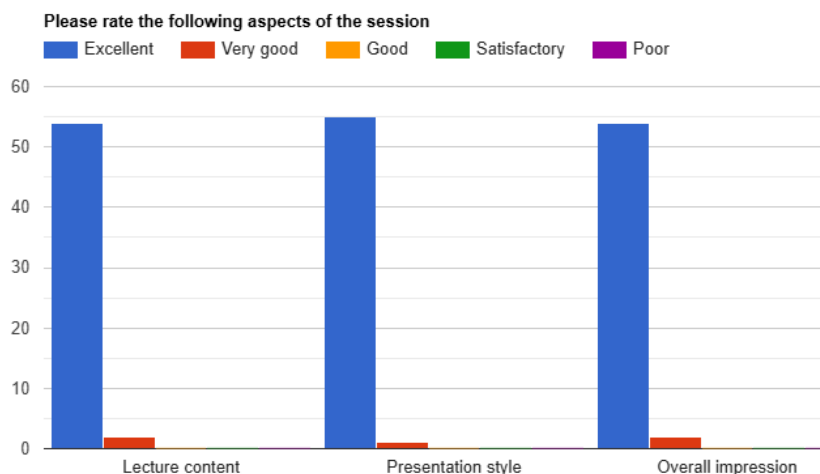

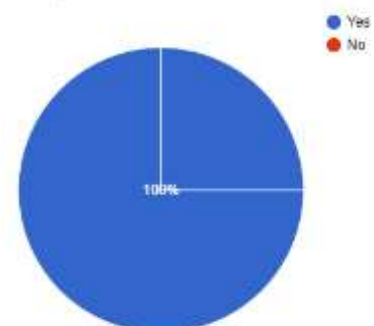

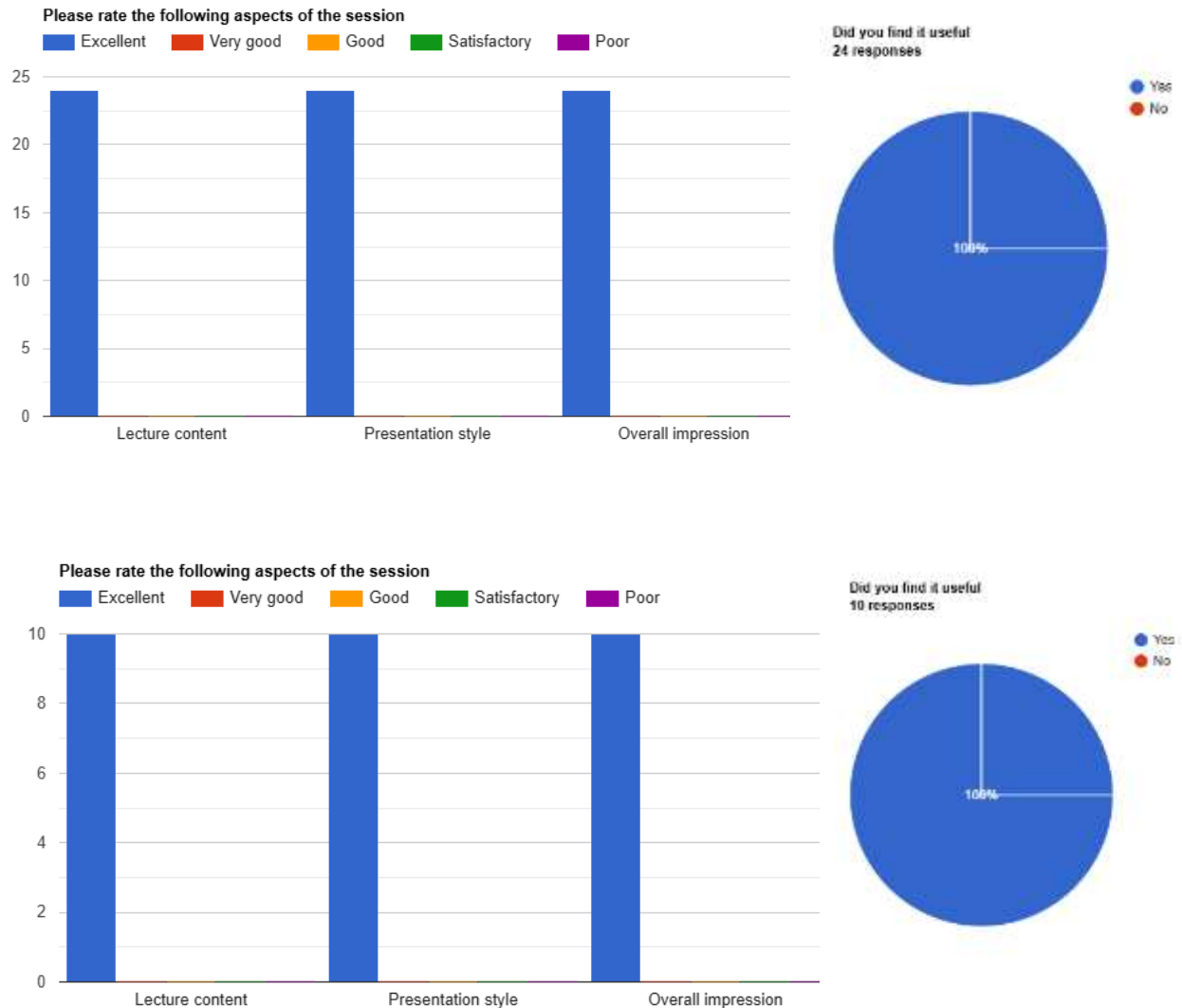
Summary Points:

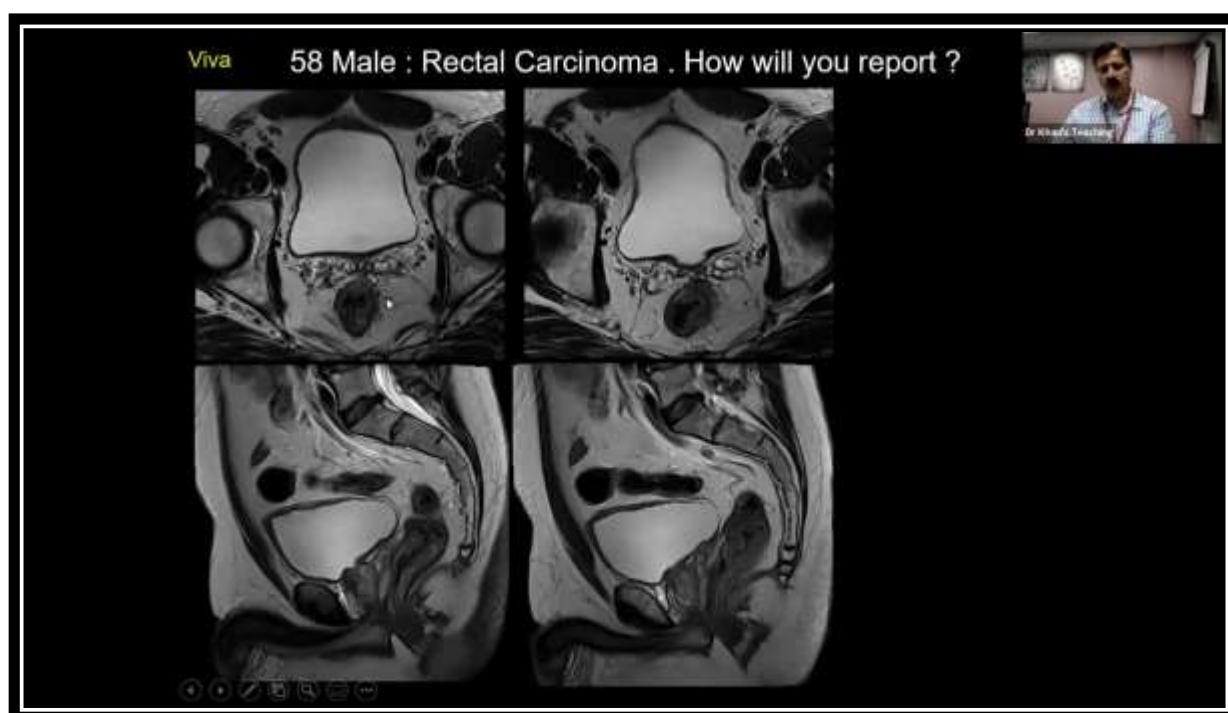
